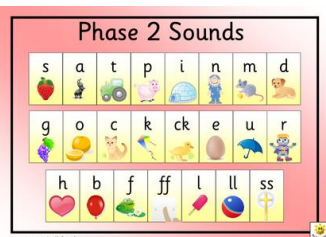
Here is an overview of some of the activities we will be doing this week, in whole class and small groups.

Topic

This week we are Going on a Dinosaur Hunt around the school playground. The children will be looking out for key features of a dinosaur environment, what they eat and where they might be hiding! We will be recording our discoveries using our knowledge of colour and texture to paint dinosaurs all the different parts of our hunt – thick oozy mud, swishy swashy grass etc.

Maths

We will be continuing to focus on our numeral recognition and ordering as well as having a Dinosaur tea party! At the tea party, the children will be thinking about good sharing: pooling the party snacks together and finding the total of both groups by counting all of them accurately using 1:1 correspondence (saying a number for each snack they count).

Letters and Sounds

This week we will be focusing on good listening skills during story time, listening to stories such as *We're Going on a Bear Hunt* and the original *We're Going on a Lion Hunt* with increasing attention and recall. The children will be joining in with repeated refrains during the story and during role-play, re-enacting the hunt in their learning environment. By the end of the week we will be looking at different elements of the story (characters, setting etc.) to write our own class version of the story.

This week the children will be learning the second set of Phase 2 sounds i, m, n, d and will be recording some of our Dinosaur Hunt
