



Half Term Challenges!

WORD CHALLENGE

Can you make a collage of our high frequency words we are learning? How many can you find from the list of words at the front of your Home Learning book? Look carefully through newspapers and magazines, cut them out and stick them in!




Extension: can you write the words? Maybe even put them in a sentence?!

NUMBER CHALLENGE adapted from

Ask your child to collect 1 object from a group of objects, both in and outdoors, eg. they may choose 1 leaf, 1 stone, 1 play figure. Focus on counting one number name for one object if your child is not doing that yet!

Create your own book, 'My Book of Numbers', by sticking the objects into a plain-paged book, where appropriate, or by sticking in photos or stickers of the objects. Repeat for all the numbers to 10 or 20 if you like! i.e. one page of 1 object with matching numeral, one page for 2 objects with matching numeral, one page for 3 objects etc.



Extension: begin to use groups of objects to add together. E.g. Can you add together your leaves and your playmobil men? How many altogether?

Super extension: how can we record this, show someone else what we did?
