

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# St Marks CE Primary School Policy for School Uniform

### The Governors expect that all children will wear the school uniform as outlined below:

	Gingham summer dress (royal blue, not navy or yellow)		

Only black shoes or black trainers may be worn to school. Any other footwear including fashion wear (e.g. clogs, high heels, open back sandals or boots) should not be worn.

Stud earrings are the only jewellery item allowed to be worn to school as other items can be a health and safety risk. Children in KS2 may wear watches to school and these should be removed for PE lessons.

All children will need the following items to be kept in school during the week for PE and drama lessons:

- Any plain white t-shirt
- Plain black or blue shorts
- Black plimsolls or black trainers

(All the above items are on sale in most Department Stores).

- One piece swimming costumes/trunks blue/black (for swimming lessons only)
- All items of clothing should be clearly marked with the child's name to avoid loss.

Please Note: If clothing is not labelled, teachers will write the name on the label of the item in a permanent pen to avoid loss.

## **Non-Compliance**

Children who come to school without the correct uniform will be allocated a spare one for the day and a warning letter will be sent home. Persistent offenders will be sent straight home or their parents will be contacted and asked to bring the correct uniform to school.

The governors cannot accept responsibility for any personal property lost or damaged.
