EU CITIZENS:

get help to apply for settled status

The deadline for the UK leaving the EU is approaching and the council wants to support Europeans living in Islington to stay.

If you are an EU, European Economic Area (EEA) or Swiss citizen, you will need to apply for settled status by 30 June 2021 (31 December 2020 if there is 'no deal') to continue living in the UK. Your rights will remain unchanged until then. You need to do this through the Government's EU Settlement Scheme at www.gov.uk/eu-settled-status

You don't need to apply if you have indefinite leave to enter or remain in the UK or if you have British or Irish citizenship (including dual citizenship).

The council offers a free identity checking service for Islington and City of London residents and their families to help with the application. For more on this and other local support available visit www.islington.gov.uk/brexitsupport
