Decorate Boiled Eggs

Ask an adult to boil eggs for you. Once the eggs are cooled, you can have fun decorating them with paint.

Which 2D shapes will you draw on yours?

Ask an adult to hide eggs around your house or garden, (you can use the eggs you have decorated).

Once they are hidden, have fun looking for them!

To make it more fun, you can ask the adult to draw a map leading to the eggs? Can you follow the instructions? Do you need to go around/next to or under the sofa?

Can you have a go at hiding the eggs and help another member of your family to find the Easter eggs?



Easter Card Handprint
