<p><b><u>What would you be famous for and why?</u></b> Our topic in the Summer Term is 'People who are famous for more than 5 minutes'. These are people who have shaped our lives by making a big difference. Create a poster about what you would like to be famous for more than 5 minutes for and <b>why?</b> Will you become famous for making a scientific discovery? Or becoming an author? Or for standing up for something that you believe in? What has inspired you to make this choice?</p>	<p><b><u>Easter Bonnet</u></b> Create you're an Easter bonnet using the materials you have at home. Be as creative as you can!</p>	<p><b><u>Easter Egg Array</u></b> Using your knowledge of arrays and your 2, 5, 10 times tables, can you create Easter egg arrays? Draw your egg array or make them using your Easter eggs! Here is an example: 2 rows of 6 eggs or <math>2 \times 6 =</math></p> 
<p><b><u>Easter Card</u></b> Create an Easter card for a family member or friend. Design it using your favourite Easter theme and write a thoughtful Easter message inside.</p>	<p><b><u>Cooking/ Baking</u></b> Ask an adult to do some baking or cooking with you. Create your favourite treat! Head over to the blog and share what you have made! How did you make it? Why is it your favourite treat?</p>	<p><b><u>Easter Egg Painting</u></b> Paint your very own Easter eggs! Choose a theme or paint them in patterns. Can you make a symmetrical pattern?</p>
