




## Pearl Class Timetable- Week Beginning Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2020

There are also activities related to each song.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><a href="#">Click Here</a></p>	<p><b><u>Literacy</u></b></p> <p>Ask an adult (or a sibling) to describe a sea animal to you, your job is to guess the sea animal by listening to the description carefully.</p> <p>You can then have turn at describing a sea animal to someone, use words to tell someone what colour/size/shape it is. Is it scary? Does it have sharp teeth?</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>You have made a tally last week, can you put your answers in a pictogram? Check the example below.</p>

<p><b>Thursday</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u><b>Maths</b></u> <u><b>Estimating</b></u></p> <p>Ask an adult to put objects in a clear container, can you estimate (guess) how many objects are inside? How do you know?</p> <p><u>Extension</u> Can more objects fit in box? Why not? If so, how many? Can you have a go at putting objects in a box and ask the adult to estimate?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u><b>Phonics</b></u></p> <p>Review your previous sound c and k, watch the jolly phonics to remind you.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><a href="#"><u>Jolly Phonics</u></a></p> <p>Can you make a word using c a t p o s ?</p> <p>Remember to use your fingers to work out how many sounds are in the word.
