This Week's Question: How did Jesus rescue people who were afraid? Watch the video below of Jesus calming the storm when his disciples were in a storm. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uYLHqdSO9OY Have you ever been in a storm? How did it feel? How do you think Jesus' friends were feeling? What else are you afraid of? What/who do you want when you are afraid? What did Jesus' friends want when they were afraid of the storm? Make or draw lifeboats and talk about how they rescue people today. In the Bible story, Jesus saw how frightened his friends were so he came and rescued them. Christians believe that God doesn't want us to be afraid and sent Jesus to earth to rescue everyone. They call him a 'rescuer' or 'saviour'.
