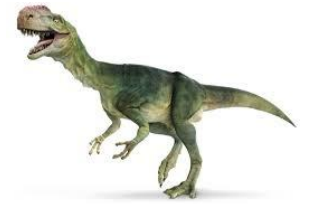




# Summer 2 – ‘Dinosaurs!’

#### PSHE

Our new topic is dinosaurs! Have a go at making a dinosaur museum at home to play in. You could make dinosaur fossils using paper or salt dough, find hats or clothes to dress up like a palaeontologist, draw or make your own dinosaurs to go into your museum.

You could draw your dinosaur on paper, cut it out and stick it onto a lolly stick. You could then decorate it with wool, googly eyes or anything else you can find!</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b>          Go to the home learning page and open the post 'The Princess and the Wizard' - Maths Resources. There you will find a PDF with activities for each day. Today you will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make a list of seven challenges you could do each day and tick them off when you complete them.</li> <li>• Make a counting wizard book, write the page numbers and collect the matching amount of objects for each number.</li> <li>• How long can you freeze like a statue?</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Family Box</u></b>          In Emerald Class and St Mark's we are one big family! Can you draw pictures of the friends you love to play with in our school and you could write a sentence about why you like to play with them.</p>
<p><b><u>Thursday</u></b></p>	<p><b><u>Topic/Literacy</u></b>          A mysterious egg has appeared in our classroom! I wonder what could be inside. Maybe a unicorn? A crocodile? An alien? A dinosaur? Write a word or a sentence to describe what you think is inside the egg, e.g. I think a frog is in the egg. From Thursday you could also share your ideas with your friends on the blog page.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b>          Go to the home learning page and open the post 'The Princess and the Wizard' - Maths Resources. There you will find a PDF with activities for each day. Today you will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Play magic counting games. You could choose 'hide and wizard' or 'what's the spell Mr Wizard?</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>RE</u></b>  <b><u>Big Question: Who cares for this special world andwhy?</u></b>          This Week's Question: How can we care for our neighbours?          Re watch the story of the Good Samaritan from last week. Jesus says that this story tells us how to 'love your neighbour'. Do you have a neighbour? Who is your neighbour? In Jesus' story, a man is hurt and needs help. What would we do today if we saw someone who was injured? (tell an adult, call 999, find a first aider or doctor) What about if we saw someone who was sad? Make a model of your own street or block of flats using construction blocks or Lego. Where do you live? Who else lives there? Who lives next to you? What can you do to show them love?</p>
<p><b><u>Friday</u></b></p>	<p><b><u>Topic/Literacy</u></b>          Use your dinosaur puppet from Wednesday to make a show for somebody at home. You could use some ideas from one of your favourite stories.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b>          Go to the home learning page and open the post 'The Princess and the Wizard' - Maths Resources. There you will find a PDF with activities for each day. Today you will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make a potion!</li> <li>• Bad spells - halve the objects</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Helicopter Stories</u></b>          Have a go at making a helicopter story with a main character as a dinosaur. What problem will happen to your dinosaur? What will the resolution be? How will the problem be solved?</p>
