	<p>Go for a walk with an adult around a garden or park. Look carefully to see what plants and flowers you can see growing. Take some photos.</p>	<p>We are continuing our topic of 'growing', this week we will be exploring growth in plants.</p> <p>What do plants need to grow healthy? Think about what we need to grow, is it the same as what plants need? How do you know?</p> <p>Watch the video and see if you were right.</p> <p><a href="#">Click Here</a></p>	<p><b><u>Counting Backwards</u></b></p> <p>Sing the nursery rhyme 'Ten Green Bottles' to help you count backwards. Can you write the numbers as you say them on a piece of paper?</p> <p>Extension- What is happening to the number of bottles each time one falls?</p> <p>Two bottles have fallen off the wall, how many are left? How do you know? Can you show the number of bottles left with your fingers? Can you record this information by writing the number sentence or drawing the bottles?</p>


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<b>Tuesday</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Motor Skills</u></b></p> <p>Find an old magazine or newspaper that your family no longer uses, can you cut out pictures or words to make a collage?</p> <p>Cutting is a great way for children to practise their independent movements of each finger, two-handed coordination, visual perceptual tasks, fine motor skills, focus and attention, eye-hand coordination and to strengthen their hand muscles.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Phonics</u></b></p> <p>This week we are learning sound 'u' and reviewing 'p'.</p> <p><b>-If you were in Miss Farah or Kamlyn's group for phonics watch Miss Adams.</b></p> <p><b>-If you were in Jamal's group watch Miss Farah's video.</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><a href="#">Click Here</a></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Listen to Kamlyn's story about 2D shapes and have a go at recalling the names of the shapes.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><a href="#">Click Here</a></p> <p>Sing this shapes song to help you describe the properties of shapes</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><a href="#">Click Here</a></p> <p>Extension- Use the worksheet below to play 'I Spy' with a partner. Your partner needs to describe the shape to you, for example: "I spy with my little eye something that has 4 equal (the same) sides" and you need to guess which shapes they are thinking of.</p>

What do you need to do to look after it?</p> <p>Keep a plant diary to record any changes you see.</p>	<p>Can you make a salad? I haven't attached a salad recipe because you can be as creative as you like and add your favourite vegetables (or fruit!). I like adding avocados and grated carrots in my salad, what do you like?</p>

The video below will show you how to. ## Fork Painted Flowers

### You will need:

- Paper
- Paint
- Forks



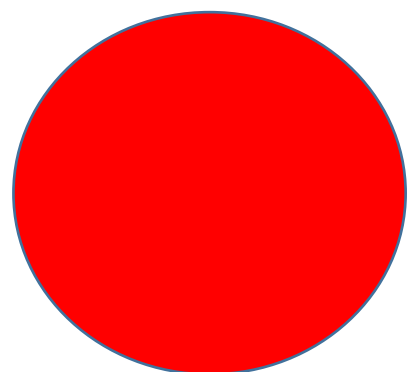
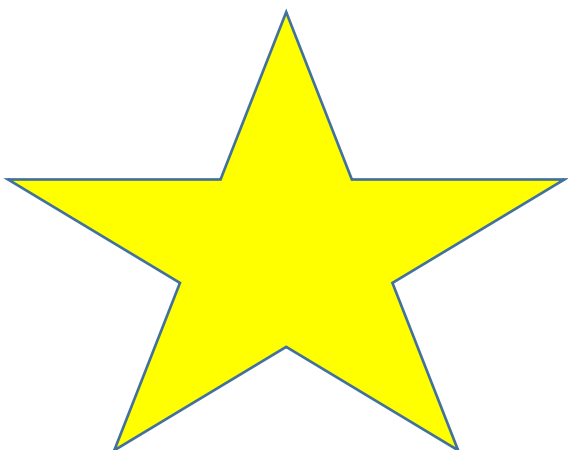
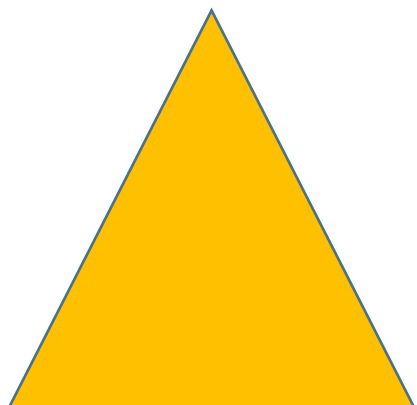
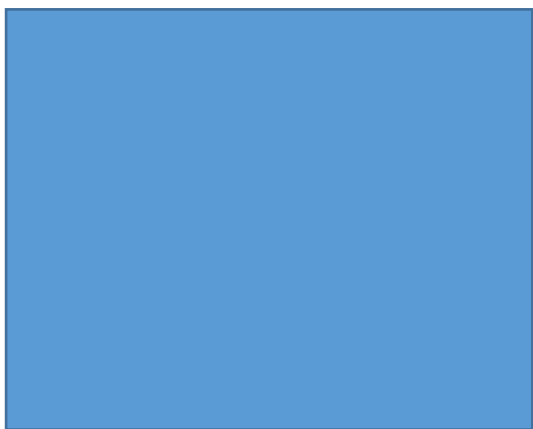
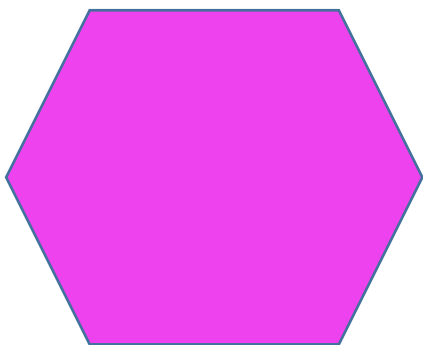
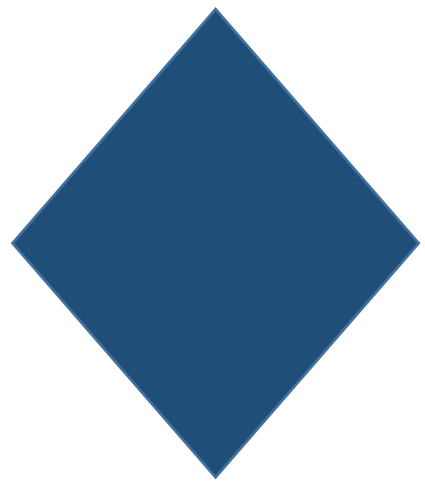
### Method:

Pour paint on a plate.

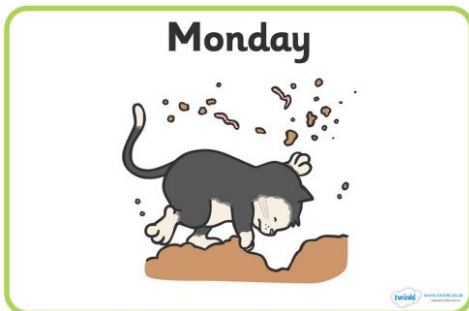
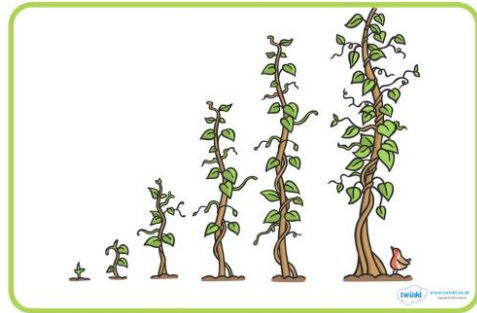
Dip your fork into the coloured paint and stamp away! Wipe your fork clean when switching colours.

Add a stem and leaves to the flowers using your finger.

Try experimenting with other things as stamps and see what kind of flowers they make. A spoon would be a great stamp for the centre of a flower and your fingertips would make wonderful petals!
