Fold the drawing in half down the middle. Paint a design on one side of the butterfly and then fold the paper in on itself so it smudges the other half of the butterfly. Open the paper up to reveal a beautiful symmetrical butterfly.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Have a go at counting on the number line.
