<p><u>Monday</u></p>	<p><u>Calendar & Weather</u></p> <p>What is the month and the date? Can you find the day on a calendar? What month will it be next? Have a go at singing this song about the months of the year.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Fe9bnYRzFvk</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Use your toys (animals, construction, dolls, etc) to make a repeating pattern. Remember a pattern can be made from colours, shapes, sizes or anything else you can think of. For example red, yellow, red, yellow or big, small, big, small. Can you say your pattern?</p>	<p><u>Spanish</u></p> <p>Can you remember any of the colours in Spanish? Try watching this song to help you. Can you find any of these colours in your house and say them in Spanish?</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=zpLQSdu4V94</p>
<p><u>Tuesday</u></p>	<p><u>PSHE/Feelings</u></p> <p>Look at the image below the table. How are the bears related? What are they doing? How are they feeling? Is this a special moment? Share a special memory between you and a parent/carer. Why was that a special time?</p> 	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Make a number line with someone at home from 1 to 20. Ask the person to say a number and have a go at saying the number that is one more and one less. Can you write this as a number sentence?</p> <p>E.g. $5+1=6$ $9-1=8$</p>	<p><u>Family Box</u></p> <p>Can you find something in your house that you have had for a long time? When did you get this and how old were you? Who gave it to you? Can you draw a picture of this and write a sentence to describe it?</p>
<p><u>Wednesday</u></p>	<p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Practise the Phase 2 and 3 sounds, can you use your sound mats to read as many as you can?</p> <p>Today we are learning the sound 'oo'. This can make two different sounds but today we are learning the same sound as in 'b-oo-k'. Can you read these words - book, look, shook, cook?</p> <p>What do these words mean? Write the sentence 'I like to cook'.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Draw and cut out some different 2d shapes. What can you make out of the shapes? Some ideas are: rockets, cars, monsters, castles. Name and describe the shapes you have used. Do the shapes have corners? How many sides do they have? Are the sides the same length?</p>	<p><u>Helicopter Stories</u></p> <p>Tell a story to someone at home and ask them to write it down for you. Choose which character you want to be. <p><u>Thursday</u></p>	<p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Watch the tricky words song and ask somebody at home to turn off the sound. Can you remember any of the words? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=R0871YrRpqY</p> <p>We are learning the sound 'oo', the same sound as in 'b-oo-t'. Go onto Phonics Play, Phase 3, 'oo' sound and try to read the words. Have a go at making a lion to celebrate this special day. You could use junk modelling, paint, pencils or other crafts.
