Y6 Parents Secondary Transfer Meeting

I am pleased to inform parents that our annual face to face meeting regarding secondary transfer is able to go ahead on site this year. A member of the admissions team will be at school to answer questions from parents about the process. Coronavirus symptoms-REMINDER

If your child has symptoms of Covid-19 please do not send them to school.

Testing also remains important in reducing the risk of transmission of infection within nurseries, schools and colleges. Continuing to take regular rapid tests will help you to identify infections early and reduce the spread. Tests can be ordered online and sent to your homes.

Positive rapid lateral flow test results

Anyone with a positive test result will need to:

- self-isolate in line with the stay at home guidance (if they test positive at school, you should arrange for them to be collected)
- book a further test (a lab-based polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test) to confirm the result, whether the test was done at home or school.
