A note on school attendance and punctuality.

At St Mark's school it is expected that pupils show high levels of school attendance and are on time every day. Parents can help by making sure that their children are ready to start school in a positive way and have everything they need for the day. Please note that although the school gate is open from 8.30am, the playground is not supervised and parents must wait with their children until school begins.

If your child is late for school please make sure you sign in at the front desk and let the school know the reason for lateness. It is also equally important that children are collected on time at the end of the school day. Teachers are busy with school duties once the class has been dismissed.

If your child is unwell please let the school know as soon as possible and keep the school informed throughout your child's illness. Please also note that we do not authorise extra holidays during term time and that children are at risk of being fined or losing their school place if they take leave of absence during term time.
