## Free School Meal Sign-Up

As you are probably aware, the lunch time meal is free at all Islington Primary Schools. However, parents and carers **must** register for the free meal by completing the on-line Citizens Portal via the following link https://www.islington.gov.uk/children-and-families/benefits-and-financial-support/free-school-meals-and-uniform-grant

Once you have competed the application (please note that applications need to be completed for each of your children as siblings will not automatically be registered for a free school meal, you will need to register them on

the portal) you will receive an e-mail confirmation which informs you of your free meal status, i.e. Eligible or Not Eligible. Parents and carers should then let the school office know their eligibility status once the email is received. Please rest assured that your child will receive a free meal, even if your status comes back as not eligible, as you are simply registering them on the Islington free meal portal.
