About the Hub: The North Access Islington Hub is the place to visit if you need support with money, food, housing, wellbeing, family, community safety or work-related issues. The North Hub is a new addition to our network, joining the Central and South Hubs in offering essential support and services to residents. Unique to the North Hub is our collaboration with the Manor Gardens Centre -Charity-, providing assistance in 10 community languages to ensure everyone is understood and supported.

Our Services:

- Money: Assistance with budgeting, finance, and debt management.
- Food: Referrals to food banks, provision of food bank vouchers, and connections to long-term support through community partners.
- Wellbeing: Support for issues affecting your wellbeing, with connections to a range of local services.
- Housing: Help with housing queries and links to services like Housing Needs, Housing Repairs, and the Citizen's Advice Bureau.
- Family: Information and advice about childcare, activities, and services for parents, carers, children, and young people.
- Community Safety: Support if you're affected by crime or anti-social behaviour.
- Work: Guidance and support whether you're looking for your first job or seeking a new one.
