Reminder: Apply for a Reception Place

We would like to remind all parents and carers of children who are 4 already or will be before Aug 31st that an application must be made for a Reception place, even if your child currently attends our nursery or has a sibling already at the school. Places are not allocated automatically, and a separate application is required through the local authority admissions process.

To ensure your child is considered for a Reception place, please make sure your application is submitted by the published deadline **January 15th 2026**. Applying on time is very important, as late applications may reduce the chance of securing a place.
